PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

- Ability to work **10- to 12-hour shifts** depending on duties in the cellar or brewhouse.
- Ability to work **overnight shifts**.

- Frequent physical movement in a manufacturing environment with moderate to loud noise.
- Ability to work on and around potentially dangerous equipment and machinery with moving mechanical parts.
- Ability to work in tight or cramped workspaces, and in high or precarious places including ladders and steps.
- Ability to work with brewing chemicals and cleaning agents.
- **Frequent lifting up to 50 lbs;** team lift or equipment required for loads above 50 lbs (full kegs, grain bags, finished-goods pallets).
- Ability to stand, walk, sit, climb, balance, stoop, kneel, crouch, and crawl for extended periods.
